Over time, these tasks can strain the back, affecting their ability to empathize and provide optimal care.

To improve back safety, it's essential to consider workplace requirements when choosing an exoskeleton.

The device should be lightweight, easy to install, and comfortable, enabling nurses to move freely and perform tasks without restriction. It must also meet hygienic standards in healthcare settings. Equally important is the acceptability factor, meaning how patients perceive and interact with the exoskeleton.
